Subject:- Exemption to Bhutan from the application of export bans by India on export of Milk Powder, Wheat, Edible Oils, Pulses and Non Basmati Rice.

- In exercise of powers conferred by Section 5 of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992 (No. 22) S.O. (E) of 1992) read with paragraph 1.3 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2009-2014, as amended from time to time, the Central Government hereby exempts export of the following items to Bhutan from any export ban:
 - Milk powder (i)
 - Wheat (ii)
 - (iii)Edible oil
 - Pulses (iv)
 - Non-basmati rice (v)
- Effect of this Notification: 2.

Export of above items to Bhutan will be exempted from any ban and without any quantitative restrictions. This supersedes earlier Notification No. 87 of 05.12.2011 & Notification No. 104 of 05.03.2012.
