

PARTICIPATION OF APEDA IN SIAL PARIS 2024

APEDA:

The Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) is an Indian Apex Export Trade Promotion Active government body set up by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Govt. of India under the Agriculture and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority Act 1985.

APEDA is the premier body of export promotion of fresh vegetables and Fruits and their Products, Meat and Meat Products, Poultry and Poultry Products, Dairy Products, Confectionery, Biscuits and Bakery Products, Honey, Jaggery and Sugar Products, Cocoa and its products, chocolates of all kinds, Alcoholic and Non -Alcoholic Beverages, Cereal and Cereal Products, Groundnuts, Peanuts and Walnuts, Pickles, Papads and Chutneys, Guar Gum, Floriculture and Floriculture Products, Herbal and Medicinal Plants, De-oiled rice bran, Green pepper in brine, Cashew Nuts and its Products etc.

It provides the crucial Interface between farmers, storehouses, packers, exporters surface transport, ports, Railways, Airways, and all others engaged in export trade to the international market.

The vision is to "create a world class organization dedicated to promote India as the "supplier of choice, agro and value-added food products in the global markets" the functions of the authority includes.

- Development of industries relating to the scheduled products for export by way of providing financial assistance or otherwise for undertaking surveys and feasibility studies, participation in enquiry capital through joint ventures and other reliefs and subsidy schemes.
- Registration of persons as exporters of the scheduled products on payment of such fees as may be prescribed.
- Fixing of standards and specifications for the scheduled products for the purpose of exports.
- Carrying out inspection of meat and meat products in slaughter houses, processing plants, storage premises, conveyances or other places where such products are kept or handled for the purpose of ensuring the quality of such products.

- Improving of packaging of the Scheduled products.
- Improving of marketing of the Scheduled products outside India.
- Promotion of export oriented production and development of the Scheduled products.
- Collection of statistics from the owners of factories or establishments engaged in the
 production, processing, packaging, marketing or export of the scheduled products or
 from such other persons as may be prescribed on any matter relating to the
 scheduled products and publication of the statistics so collected or of any portions
 thereof or extracts there from..
- Training in various aspects of the industries connected with the scheduled products.

Agri Export to the EU market.

Europe is a premium market for Indian agri products. There is a good demand for Basmati Rice, Processed Fruits, Processed Vegetables, Cucumber and Gherkins (Prepd. & Presvd), Juices & Nuts, Prepared Animal Feeder, Guargum and various other agri based products. During the year 2023-24, India's total agricultural export to European countries was worth 1384.19 million US\$. There is a good potential for increasing agri produce export to this market.

SIAL Event

The 60th edition of SIAL Paris was held during 19–23 October 2024. The results are extremely positive, showing it to be the world's large-scale event both in terms of exhibitors and visitors. The event upheld all its promises to reunite the businesses of the sector, reinforcing its position as the not-to-be-missed gathering of the worldwide agribusiness field.

Being at this show means gaining access to the heart of a business generator offering more than 60 years of expertise. SIAL Paris is the world's largest international meeting point for buyers and suppliers.

SIAL is a unique global food event featuring the world's leading retail and food service buyers in one location. Occurring every two years, SIAL attracts over 2,65,000 visitors from not only the European Union but also from the rest of Europe, the Middle East, Africa and Asia.

India is one of the potential suppliers of agricultural products in the global market. Various categories of food products, i.e., Basmati Rice, processed products, fruits and vegetables, cereal preparations, organic products etc. are exported.

The Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) has participated in SIAL Paris-2024 event and set up "India Pavilion" to showcase and market the Indian Agricultural and Processed Food Products. The event was scheduled from 19th-23rd October, 2024 at Paris Nord Villepinte, France.

Details of APEDA's participation

In the series of this, APEDA organized its participation in biggest ever edition of SIAL Paris-2024 along with exporters, processors and FPOs.

APEDA had taken 568 sqm space in Paris Nord Villepinte, France in Hall no. 3 with block number 3A-202 and Hall no. 8 with block numbers 8G 093, 8G 115, 8G 137 and had set up an "India Pavilion" for promotion of Indian Agricultural Products along with India exporters.

Approximately 50 leading member exporters joined as co-exhibitors, promoting a diverse range of agricultural and processed food products, including cereals (such as Basmati rice), processed fruits and vegetables, juices, nuts, animal products (meat, poultry, honey), groundnuts, and alcoholic beverages.

Notably, Purandar Highlands Farmers Producer Company from Pune showcased their innovative fig and jackfruit juices at the APEDA pavilion. These products received international recognition, with the jackfruit juice making its debut at SIAL Paris 2024.


